# ARGWEB – Settings



## Settings – ARGWEB Settings

- Group Full Name:** This is the full name for your ARG and will be displayed at the top of each ARGWEB app page. Text, no length limits.
- Tin-Label Contact Email Address:** For reptile surveys using refugia, it is advisable to add a tag to each tin which includes contact details. This is the email address for contact, which is printed onto the label in the tin labeling app.
- Website URL:** This is the hyperlink to your ARG's website, whether an ARGUK-mini-website or your own. Leaving ARGWEB takes you here.
- Group Map Centroid:** Many of the ARGWEB apps make use of a map function. This is the coordinates for the centre of this map when the page opens, it should be close to the centre of your area of operations. This is in decimal degrees, separated by a comma [WGS84].
- Bottom Banner Text:** There is a default copyright statement at the bottom of every ARGWEB app page (unless it is replaced by control buttons). You can replace this with custom text.

## Settings – Facebook Integration

**Facebook Group URL:** This is the hyperlink to your ARG's Facebook page, if it has one. Type in the URL, or leave blank to ignore.

**Facebook Page ID** Your Facebook page has an ID number, this is required should you wish to link your Facebook events to your ARGWEB events page.

**Facebook Token:** Should you wish to link your Facebook events to ARGWEB events apps, then you need an Authorisation token from Facebook. This is quite complex and covered in a separate guide.

## Settings – PayPal Integration

**PayPal Email Address:** When integrating ARGWEB with PayPal subscriptions, the only ARGEB setting you require is your PayPal business email address. Enter it here.

## Settings – Calendar Integration

**Calendar Embed URL:** If you use a Google Calender, there is a URL available to embed this calendar within ARGWEB (or any other website). Paste the embed UTL here.

**iCal URL:** Many calendar apps, including Google Calendar, allow an iCal feed from the calendar. ARGWEB can pick up this iCal link and display it to members. See your Calendar documentation as to how to generate an iCal link.

## Settings – Logos

Group Positive Logo	Group Negative Logo	Group Secondary Logo
This is the logo which appears on the title bar of your ARGWEB portal, and is used for ARGWEB-Generated PDFs	This is an optional logo, usually with transparent areas, which can be used on emails and other branding. The default is to use the Positive Logo if absent.	This is a rarely used option. For NIARG, it's establishment was in part lottery funded, so there is provision for a secondary logo to appear besides the Group Logo on ARGWEB app pages.
